Thank you for your interest in this newly released e-learning version of the face to face course previously held by county ACOs. The completion of this course will comply with the "TVCL Registered Club Umpire" initiative this season.\*

The course is designed to give you an overview of the basic Laws of the game and how to apply them and introduce the principles of field craft and match management. It will give you the tools to enable you to umpire matches at the basic recreational level where there are no independent umpires appointed.

**Cost** : £20 includes 1st year membership of the ECB ACO on completion of the relevant documents plus DBS, insurance, merchandise & newsletters. (Membership value £30 per annum)

## How to register :

Registration & payment must be made online.

Within two days of registering you will receive, by email, log in details to the **ECB E-learning platform** where you will be able to access the course. This email will also contain links and instructions for ECB ACO membership.
